In September, Governor Cuomo announced first-in-the-nation regulations to help protect New York State from the ever-growing threat of cyber-attacks. The new regulations require banks, insurance companies, and other financial services institutions regulated by DFS to establish and maintain a cybersecurity program designed to protect consumers and ensure the safety and soundness of New York State's financial services industry.

This hearing seeks to explore the cybersecurity needs of banking institutions and to review State laws and regulations designed to protect against cyber threats.

Persons wishing to present pertinent testimony to the Committee at the above hearing should complete and return the enclosed reply form as soon as possible. It is important that the reply form be fully completed and returned so that persons may be notified in the event of emergency postponement or cancellation.

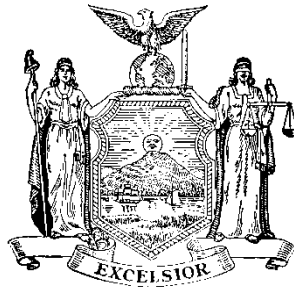
